Daily Physical Activity Tracker's Educator Module

The Daily Physical Activity (DPA) Tracker, a tool developed by VSS and available at LearnNowBC, to make it easier for students, parents & teachers to keep track of kids' physical activity levels has been in use for several months. It is supported by the DPA Tracker's Educator Module which BC educators use to access their students' DPA Logs online so they can help ensure their kids are meeting their daily physical activity requirements. Using this Module, they can view and download the information by school, student and date to ensure compliance with BC Ministry of Education requirements.
