An increasing concern over the social impact of technology led Steve to produce "Cyber Safe with Steve Dotto" with the Virtual School Society. This a series of videos and DVD that give a comprehensive overview of Social Networking, Chat, Internet Privacy and Security issues designed to teach parents how to protect their children in cyberspace. The program is the centerpiece on an initiative to promote greater online responsibility.
