with Munchkin Music**

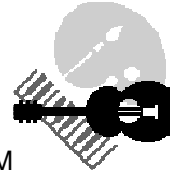

Music Sessions with Shé

Date	Theme	Overview
April 1	Music and Emotions	The students will identify with their own feelings as they listen to a range of songs and draw pictures.
April 8	Percussion Instruments and their Classifications	The students will be able to identify the different instruments using a writing/drawing component. They will also identify the various parts of the body which can make great instruments. The children will be instructed to make a basic shaker. Materials required: paper plates, dried peas, beans and rice, stapler. Colouring sheets will be provided.
April 15	Habits and Characteristics of the 'Bumblebee'	Adapted from one of Shé's songs, 'Zachary My Bumblebee', the students will listen to the song and then use a diagram to identify the various parts of the bumblebee. Diagram provided.
