Nature's Patterns – Art for Intermediate and Secondary Students with Annerose Georgeson

You will look for and identify different types of nature's patterns (such as radial and branching patterns) that are found in tree bark, leaves, animal markings, etc. In each session, Annerose will demonstrate the activity and show related artwork.
