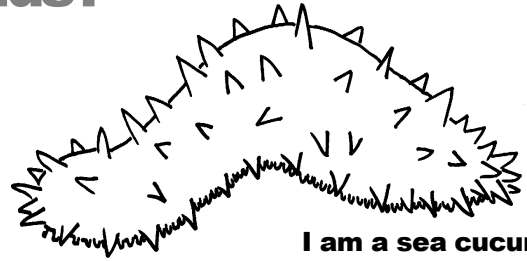

- 1) Have the students complete the worksheet by colouring the animals and drawing a line between the picture and the correct description

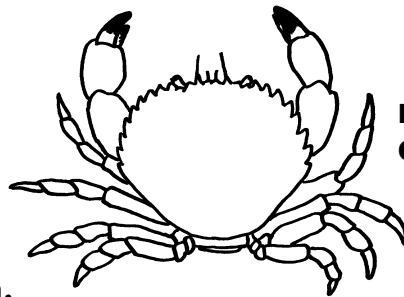
Who Are My Seashore Friends?

I have a hard shell.



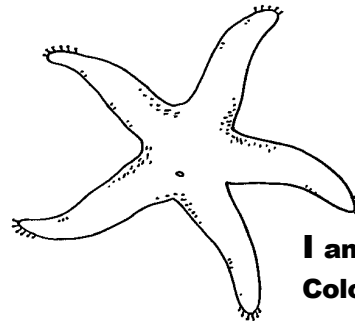
I am a sea cucumber.

Colour me red.

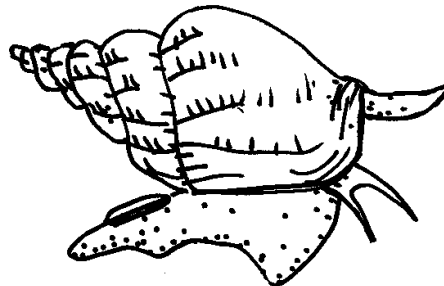
I have five arms and hundreds of feet.

I like to eat clams.



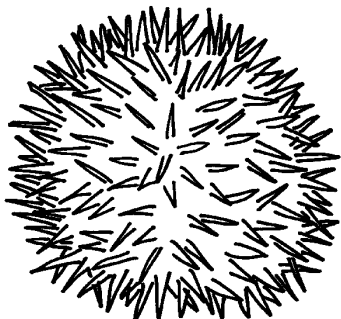
I am a sea star.
